- Accredited by the Higher Learning Commission – just like other schools

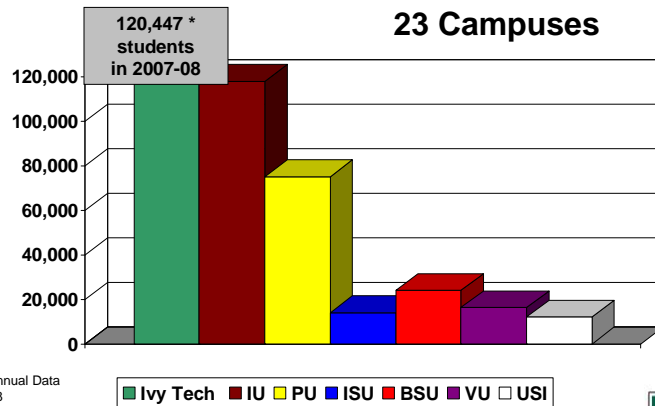

Annualized Headcount (Credit)

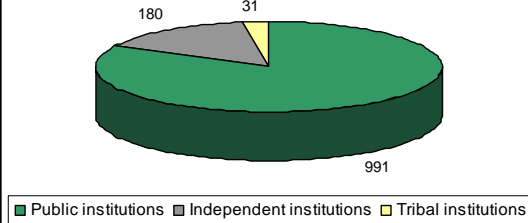

Purdue – W. Lafayette	7,518	6,888	-8%

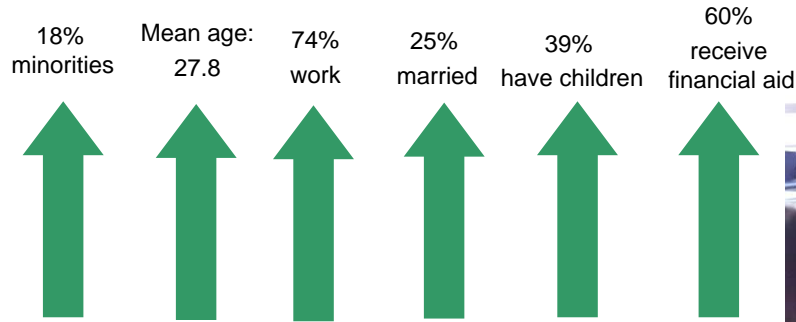

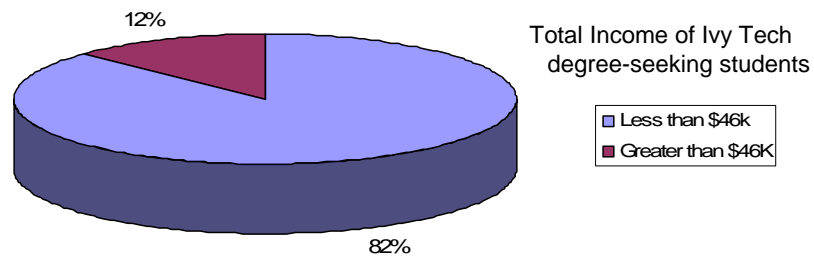

60% Receive Financial Aid

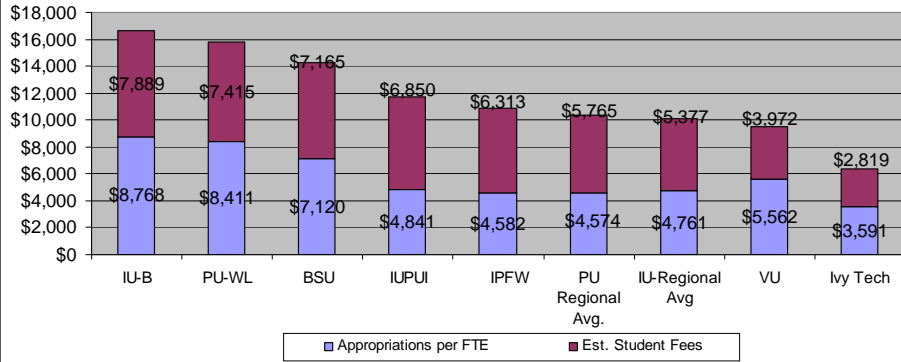

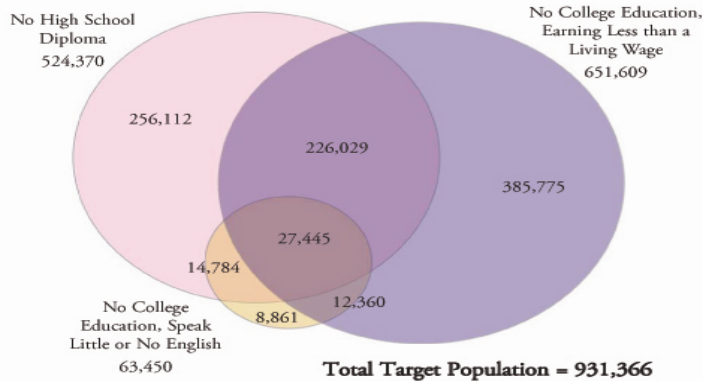

this effort shall be to **provide economic and workforce development support** to the state's employers and communities, by meeting their needs for better educated and trained, more productive, and more competitive employers and citizens. In addition Ivy Tech shall provide educational opportunities and appropriate workforce development, assessment, and training to those who have graduated from high school and want to **earn credits that will transfer** to a four (4) year college.

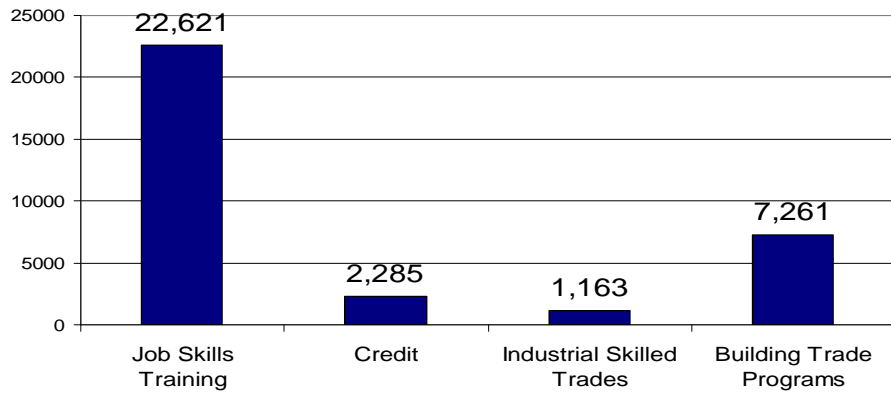

Workers Trained: 07-08



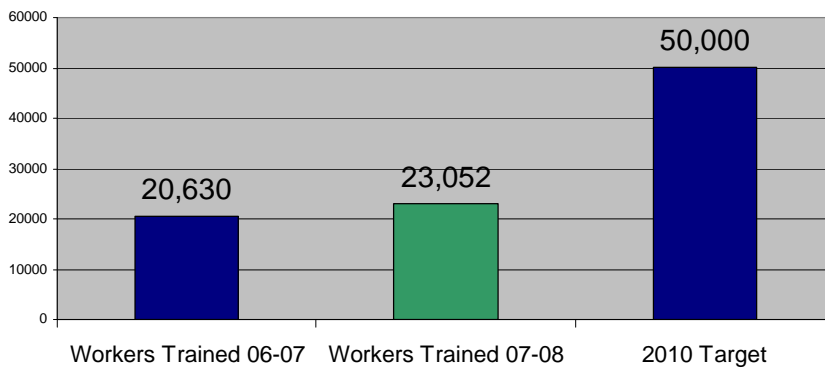
